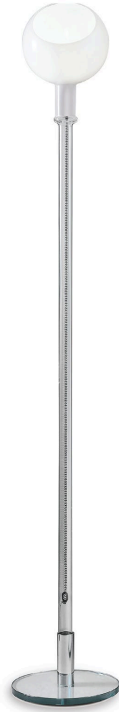

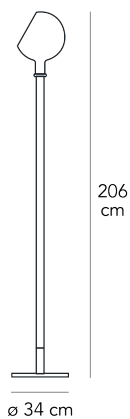


PAROLONA

Gae Aulenti e Piero Castiglioni, 1980

Designed by Gae Aulenti and Piero Castiglioni in 1980, the Parola lamp features three different kinds of glass working processes: blown glass, natural glass and natural crystal. It is an exemplary model of technical integration between artisan and industrial skills.

Floor lamp with diffused light dimmable with sliding switch. Borosilicate glass frame with base connection in chromed metal. Tinted paste blown glass diffuser, glossy. Transparent bevelled glass base. Braided fabric cable, black dimmer and plug. Schuko plug, adapter and bulb not included.
